Report to Parish Council 03rd September 2024

1. VEHICLE ACTIVATED SIGN PROJECT

On 02/08/2024 Graeme Butler from Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership installed the 3 x solar powered VAS with assistance from Cllr Chris Rowland, Volunteer Steve Grant and the Clerk Sue Grant. 2 x units were sited on the B676 Stainby Crossroads and one sited on the B676 close to Hall Lane at Stainby and 1 x unit on Bourne Road, Colsterworth. Positive feedback has already been received on vehicles slowing down when the signs are triggered by speed.

2. PRIORITIES

Colsterworth & District Parish Council priorities have been identified in previous reports:
Currently they remain:-

1. **High Street, Colsterworth** – Safety issues relating to HGVs (exceeding weight limit), speeding, parking, road narrowing, crossings, access, linked footpaths and signage

2. **Colster Way, Colsterworth** – Reports of inconsiderate/dangerous parking close to Little Legs Nursery.
3. **Bridge End, Colsterworth** - Speeding
4. **A1 – accidents**, litter and drainage
5. **Flooding/Drainage** and Soakaways

County Cllr Charlotte Vernon is liaising with Lincolnshire County Council Highways (remote meeting took place 06 March 2023) and a follow up site visit is still to be arranged.

3. ISSUES LOG – Traffic and road safety

All potholes, streetlight issues, etc. are reported on FixmyStreet and via the Clerk.

On 20/08/2024 the Clerk requested that Highway's review Water Lane & Hall Lane, Stainby under the Parish Grass Cutting Agreement due to the damaged grass verges not being re-instated.

Footpath GunS/2/2 on Water Lane, Stainby reported to LCC ROW.

4. ROAD SAFETY AND COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH (CSW)

CSW is currently on hold until another co-ordinator is found.

Speed enforcement remains the responsibility of Lincolnshire Police and will continue to be carried out by trained police officers.
