2. Chairman's remarks

The Chairman wished all a Happy Christmas and New Year.

PCSO Stuart Bowden updated the council as to police matters in the villages.

3. To receive declaration of interest in accordance with LGA 2000

Councillor J Weston declared an interest in Agenda item 7.

4. Minutes of the previous meeting

Please note the minutes are distributed in note form each month to all Parish Councillors so that they may make comments and alterations via the Parish Clerk thus saving valuable time at the Parish Council's next meeting when approving the minutes. These were agreed.

5. St John the Baptist Church "Newton Project"

Peter de Voil updated the council on progress of the project and provided insight to the aims and objectives of the committee.

6. Set Parish Precept 2015 - 2016

The clerk recommended a modest inflationary increase of 1.3% in the precept in line with the reported October Consumer Price Index (CPI). Current annual precept is £28,760 and would move to £29,133 (Band D equivalent from £38.70 to £39.20 per year). All agreed.

7. Public footpaths 14 and 1

Lincolnshire County Council has issued a proposed to modify the Definitive Rights of Way map. The proposal will delete Colsterworth footpath No 14/Gunby & Stainby Footpath 1 (part) and realign Gunby & Stainby Footpath 1 (part). Public footpath 14 runs from Water Lane, Woolsthorpe by Colsterworth westwards to the Skillington Road to join with public footpath 1 to Buckminster. The parish council will object to the proposal. It is important that our public footpaths are retained. This will result in an independent public enquiry. The onus is on the landowners to prove that public footpath 14 should not be on the Definitive Rights of Way map.

8. Clerk's Report and items arising from the Minutes

- a) Colster Way green. Land Registry legalities are taking slightly longer than expected. New swing seat in the children's playground has been fitted.
- b) Larkfleet Homes. A meeting with Larkfleet Homes representative to discuss the latest plans for the Bridge End development was not productive. However SKDC Planning department has apparently had several meetings with Larkfleet Homes over the last 16 months but have NOT had the courtesy to involve the parish council to seek our views. The clerk has written to the Chief Executive Beverly Agass SKDC regarding the lack of consultation by SKDC Planning department.
- c) Bridge End hedges. Quotes to cut the hedges on the east side of the High Street/Bridge End are being sought.
- d) Office filing cabinet. The clerk's request for an additional filing cabinet was approved.

9. Neighbourhood Plan

Madeleine Smith and Ann de Voil briefed the council on the progress of the Neighbourhood Plan. In particular they recommended that a "Landscape Character Assessment" should be carried out and is considered to be an essential part of the Neighbourhood Plan. The cost would be in the region of £4,500. The council has requested at least two quotations.

Of the original government Community Development grant of £4338 there is £688 remaining. The parish council will need to reapply for further funding. If unsuccessful this may have to be funded from parish funds.

10. Group Reports

Councillor Alan Wood regrettably informed the parish council that the Youth Club will close at the end of the year due to lack of members and adult volunteers.
