There were three members of the public present representing Distinctive Developments House Builders who spoke in support of their proposed small housing development at North Witham and answered questions from the Cllrs.

Chairperson Remarks

Chairperson Cllr Caroline Hainsworth welcomed everyone back to the Council for the 2021 year and acknowledged that the year of 2020 had been a difficult year for everyone. She thanked the Clerk for setting up remote Zoom meetings and keeping the Council business going. All Cllr's were reminded of their responsibilities as Cllr's to treat people with respect and kindness.

County/District Councillor Report

District Councillor Bellamy made the following reports: -

- There was nothing to report other than that the SKDC Planning Department was busy.
- Planning application S20/0345 had been amended slightly for access and would be going to the SKDC Planning Committee on 17th February 2021.
 Planning application PL/0004/21 recycling centre
- at South Witham had the potential to increase traffic through the Parish's.

The previous and recent flooding at Bourne Road Estate, Colsterworth will be taken forward with LCC Highways.

North Witham Play Equipment

The FCC Recycling (UK) formal Funding Agreement for FC-1781 Grant has been signed by the Clerk as signatory. Work on the new play equipment is hoped to be started soon.

Allotment Rents -

- It was agreed to increase the current allotment rents to cover additional maintenance costs by £2.50 per half allotment to £17.50 and the paddock rent by £25.00 to £525.00 as recommended by the Clerk at their Annual Renewal in April 2021.
- It was agreed for the use of hose pipes at Stamford Road allotments to revert to for filling water butts only, due to the excessive water usage during the six-month trial period from Agenda item July 2020.38. 
looking forward to seeing which resolution or resolutions we voted for were successful to be proposed at the meeting.


In the meantime, keep well and safe and your pecker up.

NATURAL HISTORY BULLETIN

Feeding birds is particularly important in the latter part of winter when other sources of berries and seeds have been used up and there are few insects about. By observing their feeding behaviour we can make improvements on how we support them. Some like the blackbird and chaffinch prefer feeding on the ground. Others like the tits are nimble on hanging feeders. Dunnock and Wren benefit from small items tucked away. Protein is in short supply. Two birds have contrasting ways of obtaining this. Pied wagtails will run along open ground catching winter gnats.



The Song Thrush will change from seeking worms when snails are about. To crack the shells it will break them on a stone, often called 'the thrushes anvil', leaving evidence in the broken shells. All these instances and more have been reported in February. In spite of the snow and extreme cold some bird song has herald the beginnings of the mating season.

It has been a month of contrasts. On 5th February it was 8C. When the sun came out a flowering evergreen shrub became the centre of interest as about a dozen 7-spot ladybirds climbed out of its branches, returning to the warmer

depth as the sun went in. A shield bug in its winter brown livery was discovered half hidden by a leaf. Two kinds of hover fly explored the flowers – just one specimen of each kind, not caught, even on camera for a photograph but hovering obligingly above the flowers .Bluebottles were more readily identifiable, their shining abdomens catching the light, a smaller greenbottle amongst them. These may all be common species but remarkable in their ability to remain active in their adult form in

Flowering plants are later this year. The first Lesser Celandine seen a month later than last year. This plant can go unnoticed on dull days as like many flowers it protects its fertile parts and opens up again when the insect pollinaters are about. No bees about at the time of writing (mid February) so they are later this year.



There have been many interesting observations this month (others saved to write about another time). An injured redwing is at a rehabilitation centre in South Witham from where it is hoped to be released as soon as it has recovered. From the same garden, the very welcome and increasingly scarce sight of a 'charm' of goldfinches on the feeders. The inquisitive and inventive antics of a grey squirrel, including the inspection of an owl box was taken over by a jackdaw. An illustrated Puffin book printed in the 1950s gives instructions for making an owl box suitable for both owls or jackdaws. A snatch of skylark song was more unusual than the first songs of Dunnock, Blackbird and Song Thrush.

A few months ago Kay Innes had reached an amazing 100 years old. On 27 January 2021, she sadly passed away, peacefully at her care home in Grantham.



Advance road works notice from Lincolnshire County Council (LCC).

B676, Stainby Road, Highfield Bridge, Colsterworth, Lincolnshire Anticipated start date for these works is 21/06/21 and is to last for 3 weeks



Lincolnshire County Councils intention to carry out maintenance works to the above structure, the location of which is shown on the above plan.

After carrying out recent inspections it has been identified that the bridge is in need of maintenance. The existing masonry wingwalls and abutments on both sides of the bridge have deteriorated and have large cracks in places. LCC are proposing to repair the defects by replacing and repointing the masonry where necessary which will help to prolong the life of the structure.

The anticipated start date for these works is 21/06/21 and is to last for 3 weeks. These dates and timescales are subject to change depending on the current Covid 19 pandemic, the availability of our term maintenance contractor and progress on this site and others.

At this stage in the design it is anticipated that we will require minimal traffic management throughout the works, with traffic signals only being required when materials/equipment are delivered or removed to or from site.
