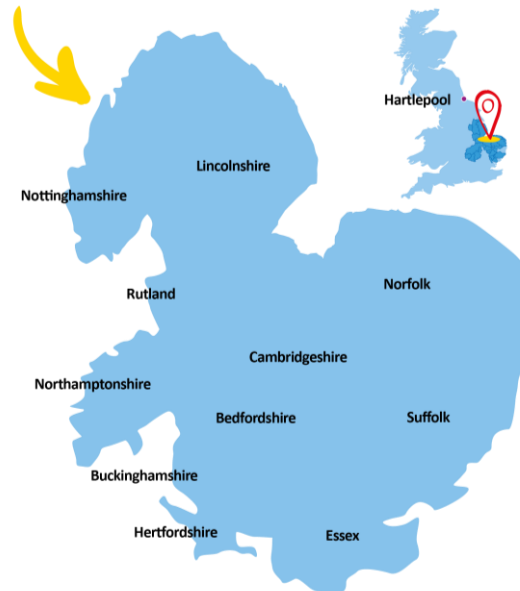

Our solution



We know your local community has felt the impact of burst pipes. We're investing £1million in the area to reduce the risk of bursts and loss of supply to local homes and businesses. We'll be improving the water pipes by slip lining 3.4km of water pipes from Gunby to South Witham.

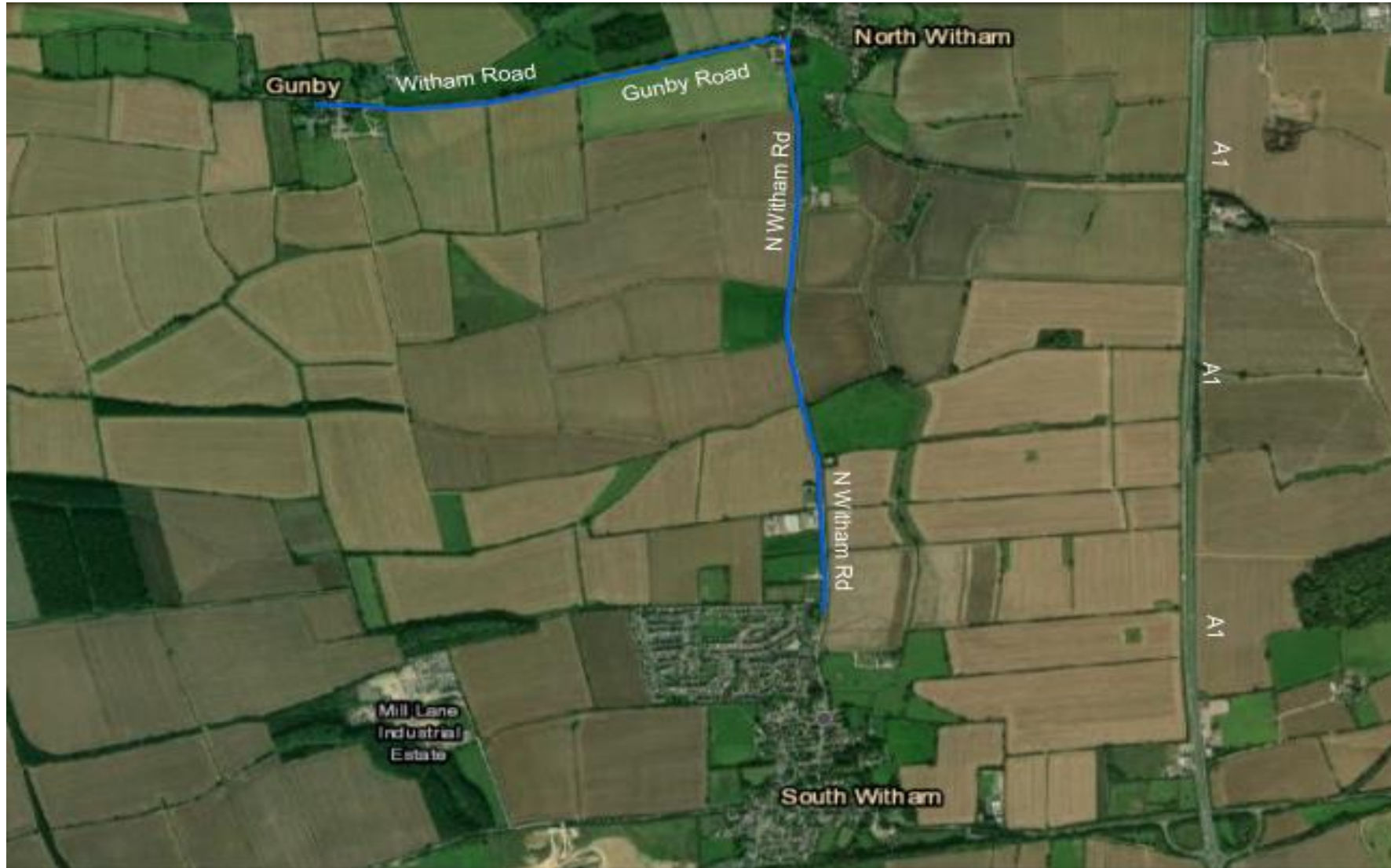
We plan to begin this work in January and expect to be complete by the end of May 2022.

What does this project involve?

To reduce the disruption to the community we will be using a sliplining technique to replace the existing pipe. This technique is used to insert preformed sections of new pipes through existing pipes. We will use this method to minimise the amount we need to dig to install new pipes; reducing our carbon footprint, which is good for the environment as well as reducing disruption to our customers.

Traffic Management

The safety of our employees and the public will always be our number one priority. Based on the width of the road, the location of our existing pipe, the plant and machinery we need to use and working area for our employees, we have agreed with the local highways authority that we will need a full width road closure. Roads will be closed in approximately 200metre sections 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for the duration of our programme.

We will always enable safe access and egress for any residents, businesses, and the emergency services from one direction or the other. There will be no through traffic and a clearly sign posted diversion route will be in place for road users which has been agreed with the local highway's authority and an expert traffic management company.

- Gunby to North Witham, Road Closure 17 January – 06 March 2022
- North Witham to South Witham, Road Closure 21 February – 08 May 2022

The dates of the closure overlap to allow our team to progress to the next section of work without needing to pause, please be ensured both closures won't be in place at the same time.
