- The Village Hall Committee (Sir Isaac Newton Memorial Hall Charity) had received a letter from Shouler & Son surveyors stating that there was no value in the remainder of the lease.
- The Social Club Committee are willing to accept the surrender of the lease and would continue to run the Village Hall for the benefit of local groups.

The member of the public finished by saying that the existing Village Hall Committee members were very sorry that the charity would not be able to continue.
