HEADLINES FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 6th DECEMBER 2022

There were no persons present for the Public Forum.

### Chairman's Remarks.

Chairperson Cllr Caroline Hainsworth thanked everyone for coming to the meeting after receiving the message from the Clerk about the heating not working in the Methodist Church Hall. Due to this they proposed that agenda items 2022.128.2 and 2022.129 be brought forward to be dealt with first. All members agreed.

# Updates for Council administration - Finance & Administration Committee Report

- 1. Finance & Administration Committee Report (Cllrs Bouvie, Hainsworth, L McShane & E O'Neill). No report this month.
- Unanimously agreed the 2023/2024 Budget
- 3. Unanimously agreed the 2023/2024 Precept Setting at £40,399.00. An increase in the Parish precept Band 'D' rate results in an increase from £50.04 to £53.16 per household per year.
- 4. Resolved to adopt and renew the CAD Finance & Administration Committee Terms of Reference (TOR) with the amendments by the Clerk.
- 5. Payments for Account were approved.

### LCC & SKDC Cllr Reports

SKDC Cllr David Bellamy Reported: -

- 1. The Local Plan Review Sites coming forward will be under consultation.
- 2. Parliamentary Consultation on Electoral Boundaries is almost complete. This has no direct impact on LCC or SKDC at the moment.

LCC Cllr Charlotte Vernon Reported; -

- 1. There is lots of information on the LCC website about the Cost of Living.
- 2. The Budget is being prepared.
- LCC is working to develop a new strategy for transport for Grantham.

Cllr Vernon stated that she would send a full written report to the Clerk to circulate to all Cllrs.

SKDC Cllr Ben Green sent his apologies.

Derelict Garage, High Street, Colsterworth Agenda item 2022.117

Unanimously agreed that the Parish Council has no interest or responsibility for the property.

On 21st November 2022 East Midlands Building Consultancy confirmed that the building is not dangerous.

LCC Parish Agreement scheme (Urban Highway Grass Cutting) Unanimously agreed the on a rolling annual basis.

Roundabout at Woolsthorpe Children's play area - Unanimously agreed to go with the Wicksteed quotation including fitting at £378.20 excl VAT.

Christmas Lights electricity contribution - Resolved to make a £30 contribution to Colsterworth Church Parochial Church Council towards the electricity costs for the Christmas lights.

Nature Trail Boundary Issues - Unanimously agreed to forward agenda the item to the next meeting to give the landowner FCC time to consider the Parish Councils approach.

War Memorial - Resolved for Cllr T Neale to start a dialogue with Colsterworth Festival of Remembrance (CFoR) to investigate working in partnership to support the restoration of the War Memorial.

### **Clerks Report**

- 1 -Nature Trail The Parish Council is liaising with the landlord FCC Communities Foundation to work together on the way forward regarding fly tipping and boundary issues. The landlord has confirmed that the repair to the bridge at the west end of the Nature Trail is temporary and they will look at further works next year if the budget is approved.
- 2 Police Quarterly Briefing questionnaire submitted to Lincolnshire Police with top three priorities, Road Safety, theft and anti-social behaviour.
- 3 SKDC report that there are no funds in their budget to repair/ replace the dilapidated Back Lane name plate junction High Street/Bridge End. It will be done when funds become available.
- 4 Report made to LCC ROW 1739169 requesting a second step below the gate at the exit from the nature trail onto FP3 Possibly erosion has made the step steeper. Priority 3 Response.
- 5 Report made to LCC ROW 1739175. FP3 from Colsterworth Nature Trail north is less than the 1M rule. Priority 3 response. LCC ROW have written to the landowner of FP3 asking to widen the path.
- 6 The Clerk is sourcing quotations for the repair to the roundabout and wet pour at Woolsthorpe Road children's play area.
- 7 Dead Pigeon under the bin at Woolsthorpe Road play area reported to the Animal Plant Health Agency (APHA) HLP185593. SKDC Street Care services do not remove dead birds. APHA attended and on 30/11/2022 reported the dead bird was unsuitable for testing.
- 8 Wobbly and slippery stile on FP15 Newton Way end reported to LINC ROW. Ref no 1745472. Given Priority 2 (3 months)
- 9 Confirmation received that PKF Littlejohn LLP will continue to be the external Auditor five financial years from 2022-23 to 2026-27.
- 10 30/11/2022 The Clerk & Cllr R Brocklebank met with the DWH's engineering Manager at the road to the Social Club who will follow up with a full written report to the Parish Council. A brief summary of the meeting below:-
- They confirmed that they will liaise with their Customer Care team to get the gulley sorted and the road swept clear.
- They believe that SKDC may be responsible for the grassed area adjacent to the road even though it is still....

.....unadopted. They will investigate and include this in their report. If DWH's are responsible, then they will arrange for tree works to be done.

The tunnel under Brunel Avenue: They said that DWH's were trying to move forward with the road being adopted but there are issues regarding the tunnel which need to be resolved. 11 - The Clerk has registered an interest with LALC and Lincolnshire Emergency Planning Team for training in relation to a future emergency plan.

- 5 LALC in conjunction with LCC Emergency Planning team will be making arrangements for any necessary training to assist Parish Councils creating/updating their Emergency plan.

It was seldom planted in Lincolnshire because it was not hardy here and it was said to take up to 50 years for it to flower. Then one planted in Scrivelsby, Lincs, flowered after 30 years. Our tree planted in the 1990s flowered after 10 years, considered to be most remarkable and possibly due to climate change. This year when the leaves finally fell, the remains of flowers could be seen, all on the upper branches.

# NATURAL HISTORY BULLETIN

In 2002 there was a spectacular display of colours from autumn leaves. This included a tulip tree – part of the amenity planting in Woodlands. The tulip tree was introduced to Britain in the seventeenth Century brought from the southern parts of what is now the USA.



The winter is a good time to observe and record trees. To identify them you not only have the newly revealed twigs, buds and characteristic silhouette, but also the fallen leaves and possibly some fruit too. Any mature trees are part of the history of our parishes. For example two on Woolsthorpe Road were planted when development destroyed two mature trees. They were purposely replaced by trees known to develop quickly. They were grown by children at Colsterworth school as part of the Tree For Life Scheme just before the scheme had to finish. They therefore bear witness not only to a remarkable scheme but also to those that took

part in it. These Trees For Life, like

other mature ones are busy working now to clean up the air round us and protect our health.

Garden trees are also important whether native or exotic. Like the garden pond they can be the last bastion for wildlife. This bulletin has to be in early because of the Christmas period but as always at this time of the year observations include many of birds at feeders. Blackbirds and Robins now back in numbers, continue behaving aggressively over territory. A long tailed tit family have returned to a garden after being frightened off by a cat. Greater Spotted Woodpeckers provide colour and much interest as young birds begin to develop more adult plumage. Every record of a finch is valuable. Along the River Witham there are the first winter visitors amongst the Little Egrets found throughout the year. A follow up from last years note on a large grass snake - one found dead in the same area was probably caught out of hibernation when mild weather turned cold but our hedgehogs seem to be tucked away securely.

### TO LOOK FOR IN JANUARY AND THROUGHOUT 2023

Could we make it a special year for trees – noting any mature trees we still have, any descriptions of them and what is known of their history. We have survey information from previous years to make comparisons. Are you one of the children who planted a 'Tree For Life'? Do you know where it is? How is it doing?


