



**HIGHWAYS & FOOTPATHS**  
**Report to Parish Council 06 June 2023**

At the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council on 09 May 2023, no Councillors put themselves forward to form a Working Group but would volunteer on an ad hoc basis as and when required.

**1. VEHICLE ACTIVATED SIGN PROJECT**

- Resolved to install new VAS at North Witham and Woolsthorpe – this work has now been completed and signs installed
- Signs for B676 and Stainby deferred for further consideration – funding held in earmarked reserves

**2. ROAD SAFETY AND COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH (CSW)**

- No roadside checks have taken place
- Some equipment is still on loan with Corby Glen Parish Council
- Some residents have come forward as volunteers. Training requirements and administration of the scheme to be investigated further.

**3. FOOTPATHS**

All routine issues relating to footpaths are dealt with by the Clerk and reported to Council in Clerks Report/ Correspondence.

**4. PRIORITIES**

Colsterworth & District Parish Council priorities have been identified in previous reports:  
Currently they remain:-

1. High Street, Colsterworth – Safety issues relating to HGVs (exceeding weight limit), speeding, parking, road narrowing, crossings, access, linked footpaths and signage
